## **⊠**Equipment List for Evening Kayaking Trips **№**

All though we offer dry bags to help keep gear dry, everything that comes on the kayaking trip runs the risk of **getting wet**. We therefore recommend that you only bring personal gear that can get wet or damp during the trip. Items that must stay dry such as cameras or other electronic devices, change of clothes or person affects should stay in your vehicle.

TAC will provide: synthetic shirts, paddle jackets, paddle pants, life jackets and wet suits (when necessary).

## What you will need:

- **3** Reusable water bottle
- C3 Hat and sunglasses
- Wet shoes or any type of shoes that can get wet. You may be walking on rocky beaches.
- C3 Sweatshirt or sweater and a dry change of clothes
- An extra layer for warmth
- **C3** A beach towel
- **&** Headlamp

## **Recommended Items:**

- **3** Waterproof camera (Suggested: protective case and lanyard)
- A Polyester shirt or other synthetic clothing (layering)
- Water resistant pants such as Gore-tex
- Swim suit or swim trunks nice to wear under your clothing.
