

## **Directions to Castle Peak:**

Castle Peak is located 8 miles West of Truckee off the Boreal Ski Resort exit. **Exit # 176.** Park along the road (Bunny Hill Rd./Boreal Ridge Rd) near the brown sign for Donner Summit California State Sno Park. You must have a permit to park here. Permits are available for \$15 online or at participating vendors. Your guide will be set up along the road leading to the brown Sno Park sign with the snowshoes staged.

**From Sacramento:** Take I-80 East to the Boreal / Castle Peak exit, #176. Go right off the exit and take an immediate left, following signs towards 'Boreal Inn' and 'Pacific Crest Trailhead'. The safest place to park is past the brown building-Boreal Inn along the road-Bunny Hill Rd./Boreal Ridge Rd. You will see a brown sign for the Donner Summit Sno Park at the end of this road. You must have a permit to park here. Permits are available for \$15 online or at participating vendors. Your guide will be set up along the road leading to the brown Sno Park sign with the snowshoes staged.

## From Reno, Nevada

Take I-80 west 45 miles and exit Boreal / Castle Peak exit, #176. Go left off the exit and under the overpass. Make a left at the T-intersection, following signs for 'Boreal Inn' and 'Pacific Crest Trailhead'. The safest place to park is past the brown building-Boreal Inn along the road-Bunny Hill Rd./Boreal Ridge Rd. You will see a brown sign for the Donner Summit Sno Park at the end of this road. You must have a permit to park here. Permits are available for \$15 online or at participating vendors Your guide will be set up along the road leading to the brown Sno Park sign with the snowshoes staged.

## **From Kings Beach**

Take Highway 267 to I-80 west and exit Boreal / Castle Peak exit, #176. Go left off the exit and under the overpass. Make a left at the T-intersection, following signs for 'Boreal Inn' and 'Pacific Crest Trailhead'. The safest place to park is past the brown building-Boreal Inn along the road-Bunny Hill Rd./Boreal Ridge Rd. You will see a brown sign for the Donner Summit Sno Park at the end of this road. # From South Lake Tahoe

Take Hwy 50 north along the east shore. Just after Glenbrook, take left on Hwy 28 toward Incline Village. There is no stop sign or stoplight for this turn. Follow Hwy 28 to King Beach and follow directions from Kings Beach.

# **From Tahoe City**

Take Highway 89 north to I-80 west and exit Boreal / Castle Peak exit, #176 Go left off the exit and under the overpass. Make a left at the T-intersection, following signs for 'Boreal Inn' and 'Pacific Crest Trailhead'. The safest place to park is past the brown building-Boreal Inn along the road-Bunny Hill Rd./Boreal Ridge Rd. You will see a brown sign for the Donner Summit Sno Park at the end of this road. # From Truckee
